

Year 2 - PHES Medium Term Curriculum Map - Term 3.2 2021-2022



ENTRY POINT

Make the classroom or other area into a restaurant/café, based on those commonly found in the home or host country.

As a class, spend time planning what your restaurant/café will need to make it feel 'authentic'

Begin by discussing the jobs that need to be done and divide the class into small groups, each group responsible for one aspect. The groups should then plan and 'create' their area for an afternoon of role play.

Children will be making fruit kebabs to tie in with the English topic of Instructions.

 choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure length/height in any direction (m/cm); mass (kg/g); temperature (°C); capacity (litres/ml) to the nearest appropriate unit, using rulers, scales. thermometers and measuring vessels
