#### Alongside the 3 units, the children will:

- Continue to learn words, apply spelling and pursue accuracy in spelling.
- Investigate spelling rules and exceptions, including developing understanding of word roots, prefixes and suffixes.
- Secure the use of punctuation marks in their writing and to use them to guide intonation in reading.
- Read aloud in class clearly and with confidence.
- Speak confidently and make effective contributions in group and class discussions.

Handwriting in Year 4 should be cursive, legible, neat and tidy.

 Children will practise using diagonal and horizontal strokes that are needed to join letters and increase the legibility, consistency and quality of their handwriting.
