Literacy (reading, writing, spelling and handwriting)

- During Term Two, the children will cover fantasy stories, newspaper reports and poems from other cultures.
- Children are expected to read at home for twenty minutes, three times a week.
- Our daily reading will continue to develop their comprehension skills. This term we are focusing on our inference skills and reading between the lines.
- Spelling patterns are revised and tested weekly.
- Handwriting is practiced weekly.

Numeracy

- The children must continue to practise their times tables, supported by parents, for our weekly tests.
- During Term Two, the children will cover number and place value, the four operations and fractions, 2D shapes, time and mental calculation strategies.

<u>International Primary Curriculum (IPC) – includes Art, DT, ICT, History, Geography,</u> <u>Science</u>

- During IPC we will be focusing on two topics beginning with 'Chocolate' and finishing with 'Material World'. Each topic uses a cross curricular approach and is integrated with English and other specialist subjects.

Home learning and Communication diary/reading records

- Homework is given out daily. The homework timetable remains the same as Term One.
- Children are expected to write their homework down daily, in their blue diary.
- Timetables are stuck into their Homework diaries.
- The reading books are changed weekly.
- The pink reading log contains information about what books each child has read.
