



UNIFORM POLICY

RATIONALE

The aim of the Park House English School (PHES) uniform policy is to ensure that students attend school in the correct uniform at all times.

AIMS

The implementation of the policy will be fair, firm and consistent for all students. Students, teachers and parents will be made aware of the correct uniform so that they understand what is allowed and what is not allowed when attending Park House English School.

PROCEDURES

Uniform – All Key stages

Students are required to wear the correct uniform at all times when at Park House English School.

Shoes

School shoes should be black leather (or leather look) and polished. **Canvas shoes, sports branded shoes, trainers or trainer-style shoes should not be worn. This includes black leather trainers.** Parents should select your child's school shoes carefully to avoid having to purchase a second pair.

The image below represents shoes **that are deemed acceptable** to wear at Park House English School;



The image below represents shoes that are **NOT** deemed acceptable to wear at Park House English School;

All the footwear shown are examples of footwear that are NOT permitted

- Sports fabric/textile material on the main or in part of the shoe design
- Colours other than black for the main shoe, laces, sole trim or other visible shoe detail
- Bold branding, logos or informal design features
- Trainer style shoes
- Low lace trainer-shoes; i.e. Converse style, Vans or hybrid trainer-shoes





COMMON EXAMPLES – footwear NOT PERMITTED at PHES

The trainer styles below are common examples of footwear that is not permitted at PHES. PHES do not regard these as traditional formal office attire shoes.



Key features that will help you decide on the appropriateness of footwear are shown below.



Jewellery

Jewellery should not be worn at any time by students. This includes necklaces, rings, bracelets, anklets, sunglasses, nose piercings or anything else deemed as jewellery. A single set of small ear studs are permitted.

A wristwatch may be worn by students, however, the school will not be held responsible for any damage or loss to the item.

Make-up

Students should not wear any form of nail varnish when in school. Discreet use of make-up (in secondary) may be worn by students, however, excessive use of make-up will not be tolerated.

Hair Styles / Headwear

Students at Park House English School must not have extreme hair styles. This includes the use of bright colours, wearing of combs, caps, hats, bandanas and any other headwear that can be considered extreme.

Hoodies / Sweatshirts

Hoodies (Including PHES School Trip type hoodies) or non-PHES jumpers, sweatshirts or jackets should not be worn and will be confiscated, even in colder weather. Please be aware that Park House English School will not be held responsible for any item of clothes that is confiscated as a result of not following the school rules.

A PHES fleece and school jumpers are available to buy from the school's uniform supplier.

Gender Specific

Boys:

- Must have their shirts tucked in at all times when on school premises.
- Fashion belts with large buckles should not be at any time

Girls:

- Must have non-fitted shirts tucked in at all times when on school premises.
- Skirts must be knee-length and adhere to the expectations of the country that we live in.

Uniform Guidance

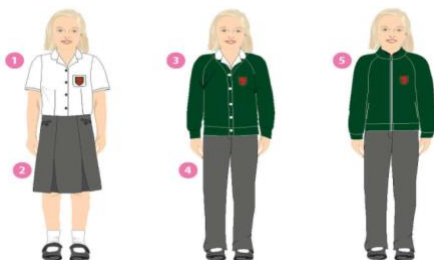
Park House English School uniform listed and illustrated below;

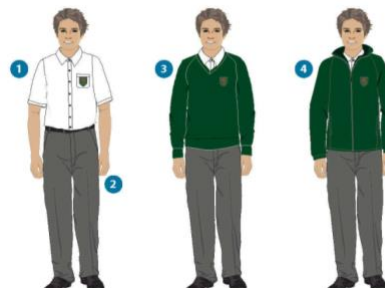

Boys

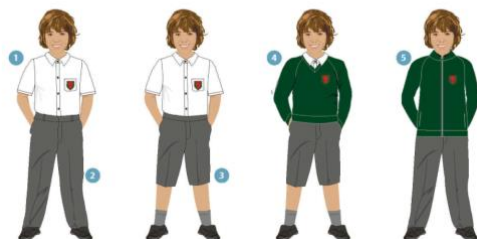
1. Boys Short Sleeve Shirt
2. Boys Shorts (primary only)
3. Senior Boys Trousers
4. Jumper
5. Polar Fleece (Optional)
6. Black Socks

(NB: Boys wear trousers from Year 7 upwards)

Years 7 - 11 Boys



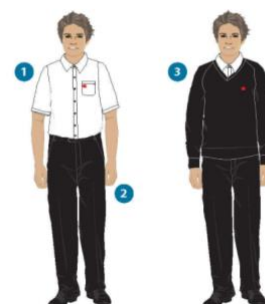
Early Years to Year 6 Boys



6th Form Uniform Boys

- Black tailored trousers
- White Park House shirt. If wearing a vest or t-shirt underneath, it must be plain white
- Park House black fleece jacket/Black v-neck pullover
- Black socks
- School tie

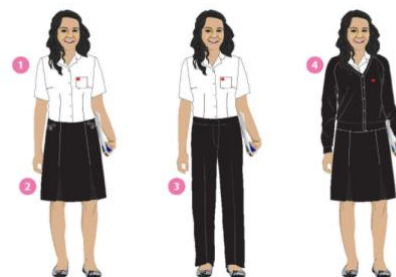
Years 12 & 13 Boys



6th Form Uniform Girls

- Black tailored trousers or skirt: knee length or longer and not tight fitting
- Park House blouse with plain white t-shirt or vest worn underneath
- Park House black v-neck pullover
- Black socks/ tights
- Black headscarf (if worn)

PE kit

- Park House kit shorts
- Park House kit t-shirt
- Park House kit socks or white sports socks

- Training shoes with non-marking soles

Swimming Kit

- Black swimming shorts or trunks for boys
- One piece black swimming costume for girls
- Goggles
- Flipflops
- Towel

Equipment Requirements

- Pen, pencil, ruler, eraser, maths equipment
- Mobile phones / Devices are not to be used in school without permission of the classroom teacher
- Relevant text and exercise books
- School planner/Diary. (This should be signed by parents and form tutor/Class teacher each week)
